Facility: Short-term (5 days) detoxification facility. Many residents are medicated to ease alcohol or drug withdrawal. Many guests will be moving on to longer-term rehabilitation centers.

Restrictions: Limited to 4 AA members. Visitors must sign in. The Chairperson of that particular meeting should know all volunteers.

Visiting spouses, family or friends is prohibited. Sponsors should accompany recent alumni who wish to volunteer for this commitment.
